“The Light of the World”

John 8:12-21

1. What is the significance of Jesus declaring the words found in verse 12 in relation to the Jewish lighting ceremony?
2. What does Jesus’ “I AM” statement, in verse 12, indicate to His audience? And, how does the context make that statement especially meaningful?
3. How do Jesus’ claims of Himself as bread, water, and light point back to the exodus?
4. Although Jesus doesn’t owe anyone an explanation, what three points of evidence does He use to establish His testimony?
5. Since Jesus promises the light of eternal life to those who follow Him, what does that indicate about those who do not? (See verses 12 and 21)
6. If we want to truly know God and be saved, who must we seek to know and follow after?
7. What is one aspect of this week’s text/sermon that was most meaningful to you?
