“The Scandal of God’s Light”

John 8:21-30

1. What does Jesus say will be the reason that the Jewish leaders will die in their sins? (v. 24)
2. What’s the difference between believing in Jesus to get you out of a crisis or to solve a problem and believing in Jesus to save you from your sins? Why is this an important distinction?
3. What is the monumental claim Jesus makes about the things He does and the words He speaks?
4. Verse 30 is both ironic and profoundly significant. What does it indicate to us about the relationship between the truth of God’s Word and the power of God’s Spirit? (See 1 Cor. 2:14)
5. What is it that keeps people in the darkness of their sins instead of seeing the light? (See 2 Cor. 4:3-4)
6. What do unbelievers *not* need to hear from us, and what do they need to hear? (See 2 Cor. 4:5-6)
7. What is one aspect of this week’s text/sermon that was most meaningful to you?
