1. How would you feel if you were the sisters and found out Jesus delayed two more days? Despite their feelings, and our own, what does the text tell us about Jesus’s motive for delaying according to verses 3, 4, & 5?
2. Even though Jesus may not always act in our timing or in the way we would like, what assurance is given in this week’s text that we can cling to during our own times of pain and suffering?
3. Why do the disciples not want to go to Lazarus? What is Jesus’s response?
4. If you were one hundred percent certain of Jesus’s love for you and God’s favor toward you, how different might your prayers be?
5. Why does Jesus call death “sleep”?
6. Does your response to Jesus’s teachings ever parallel Thomas’s?
7. What hope do you find in this week’s passage?
