**Philippians 3:17-21**

1. Paul exhorts the believers in Philippi to join with him and others as they strive to imitate Christ in their lives. What is the value of imitating Jesus and following the example of those who are also striving to live like Him?
2. What is something you've seen in another Christian that stood out to you and that you try to pattern your own life after?
3. Paul also provides a description of those whom we should not follow. What five statements are made about them, and why are they identified in this way?
4. How should Paul's reaction, as he thinks about these people, inform our own perspective on people like that?
5. In verse 20, Paul reminds the church that their citizenship is in heaven. What difference does this reality make in your life, especially when it comes to human government and politics?
6. What are some kingdom principles and expectations we are called to live by regardless of what's happening in the realm of American politics?
