### **“Walking in the Truth”**

#### **2 John 1-5**

1. Think about the last time you sent someone a hand-written letter. When is the last time you received a hand-written letter? In what ways, if any, are writing and receiving hand-written letters different than emailing?
2. What two major themes do we find John repeating in verses 1-5?
3. Although the attributes of truth and love are intrinsically connected, when have you experienced what seemed to be a tension between truth and love in your own life?
4. What is the difference between knowing the truth and “walking in the truth”?
5. What is the result of professing to love without the foundation of truth? Conversely, what is the result of claiming to walk in the truth while not demonstrating love?
6. How is genuine, gospel-centered unity dependent upon both biblical truth and love?
7. In what ways can we, as a church, begin to cultivate a greater love for God’s truth, and therefore develop greater unity as a covenant community?
