“A Cross-Centered Command”

John 13:31-38

1. Consider the context of the Father and Son receiving glory according to John 13:31-32. What does this teach us about Judas' evil intentions and betrayal? And, what larger lesson does this teach us about the forces of evil and darkness in relation to the glory of God's sovereignty? (Refer to Genesis 50:20 and Romans 8:28)
2. How does Jesus, and His sacrifice upon the cross, reveal an aspect of God's glory unseen in the Old Testament?
3. How is Jesus' "new commandment" in John 13:34 different from the command to love in Leviticus 19:18? How did Jesus demonstrate that love for His disciples?
4. In what way should Jesus' example be the driving influence in our genuine love for others, especially other believers?
5. According to Jesus in John 13:34-35, what is the result of loving one another as He has loved us? And, how does this identify true followers of Jesus for the world?
6. How is grace promised to Peter in John 13:36-38?
